Sunday, December 28th 1851.

Begins with light breeze from the N. & Chubby heading S.W. Middle part heading N.W. & under short-sail. latter part made sail heading S.W.

Monday, Dec. 29th 1851.

Begins with moderate breeze from the N. steering S. One sail on right. Middle part heading N.W. under short-sail. latter part made sail. the watch employed in repairing, & repairing the main top sail, at 12. One seal the top sail.

Long. 113. 43. E.

Saw one seal.

Tuesday, Dec. 30th 1851.

Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. heading N.W. at 2. tacked to the S.E. Middle part heading N. under short-sail. latter part light breeze & below made sail. the watch employed in repairing & heading the fore part. One English Bark on right steering S.W. to back.

Wednesday, Dec. 31st 1851.

Begins with light breeze from the S.W. heading S.W. Middle part under short-sail. latter part made sail steering S.W. saw porpoises & jumpers.

Saw one Porpoise to land the first of 1852.

Thursday, January 1st 1852.

Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. steering S.W. Middle part heading S.W. under short-sail. latter part light breeze & variable with fog banks. Made sail heading to the eastward, no land.

Cruising of Cape Cod, January, 1852.

Friday, January 2nd 1852.

Begins with light breeze from S.W. heading S.W. Middle part heading N. under short-sail. latter part light breeze from S.W. made sail steering S.W. by N. saw jumpers porpoises & Killen.

Long. 116. 45. E.

Saturday, Jan. 3rd 1852.

Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. steering S.W. Middle part heading S.W. under short-sail. latter part fresh breeze. Made sail steering S.W. smoky weather.

Lat. 36. 15. S.

Long. 116. 35. E.

Saw one seal.

Sunday, Jan. 4th 1852.

Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. & Chubby heading S.W. saw one seal. steering S.W. Middle part heading to the eastward under short-sail. latter part light breeze & variable. Made sail.

Lat. 33. 52. S.

Long. 116. 30. E.

Monday, Jan. 5th 1852.

Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. steering S. Middle part heading S.W. under short-sail. latter part made sail steering S.W. strong breeze from the N. to back.

Lat. 35. 28. S.

Long. 114. 50. E.

Tuesday, Jan. 6th 1852.

Begins with strong breeze from the N. & Chubby steering S.W. at 2. took in the fore-sails & double reefed the top-sail heading S.W. by the wind. Middle part under short-sail. latter part moderate breeze. Made sail, no land.

Lat. 36. 16. S.

Long. 115. 03. E.
