Saturday, Feb. 28th 1852
 Begins with strong breeze from S.W. & hazy, heading S. under
 short sail. Middle part S.W. & S. under short sail. Latter part made
 sail heading S.W.

Sunday, Feb. 29th 1852
 Begins with strong breeze from S.W. & hazy, heading S.W.
 Middle part heading S.W. under short sail. Latter part moderate breeze
 made sail heading S.W. thick & smoky.

Painted the old boat.

Tuesday, March the 2nd 1852
 Begins with moderate breeze from the S. heading N.W.
 Middle part S.W. under short sail. Latter part light breeze
 from S.W. made sail heading S.W. then weather permitted
 the old boat & House, on top.
 Lat. 29. 24. N
 Long. 109. 00. W

Wednesday, March the 3rd 1852
 Begins with light breeze from S.W. heading S.W. at 3.
 tacked to the S. Middle part under short sail. Latter part light breeze
 from the S. made sail heading S.W. so ends.
 Lat. 28. 55. N
 Long. 109. 50. W

Thursday, March the 4th 1852
 Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. heading S. Middle
 & latter part strong gales, heading S.W. under a main top sail &
 fore sail.
 Lat. 28. 22. N
 Long. 108. 40. W

Friday, March the 5th 1852
 Begins with strong gales from S.W. heading S. under a close
 reefed main top sail & fore sail. Middle part the same. Latter
 part strong breeze & smoky. Made sail heading S.W.
 Lat. 28. 04. N
 Long. 109. 20. W
