Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. heading S. Middle
part the same. latter part strong gale from S.W. heading S.W.
under close reefed top sail & fore sail. so ends.

Begins with strong gale from S.W. heading S.W. under
close reefed top sail & fore sail. Middle part took in the
fore top sail & fore sail. latter part light breeze & variable southerly
much the same. Made sail, the watch employed in ship's duty.

Wednesday, April the 21st 1852
Begins with light breeze from S.W. heading S.W.
at sun set backed to the N. & took in sail. latter part made sail
heading N.W. toward S. light breeze.

close reefed top sail & fore sail. Middle part took in the fore
top sail & fore sail. latter part set the same. so ends.
