Begins with strong gales from the S.W. heading S.W. under close

ship to the S.W. set a close reefed top sails, jib & main sail, saw fin
backs, so brds.

& she reefed the top sails, & furlled the jib & main sail at
sun set took on the fore top sail & fore sail, strong gales.
Middle part the same, latter part Rec'd ship to the S.W. & set the
fore sail, saw fin backs.

fore top sail, so brds.
