Latter part made sail steering N. by E. light breezes the water employed in ships deck. the cooper making second tier casks out of old Oib pipe shoeks.

Begins with light air from the S. steering N. by E. Middle & latter part. light air. variable. & calms. saw pumps. one sail in sight.

Saturday November the 6th/pr
Begins with light air from the S. steering N. by E. the Wm. Badger. In sight. whaling, at 4 P.M. saw sperm whale. at 5. lowered three boats. at sun set struck & killed one whale. at 8 took the whale to the ship & took on sail. heading to the Eastward. latter part but in the whale & cleared up the deck. the Wm. Badger. In company. hauling, heading N. Latt. 23. 23. S.
Long. 49. 24. E.
Spoke the Wm. Badger. 1450 galls.

Sunday, Nov. the 7th/pr
Begins with moderate breezes from the S. heading S. by E. hauling. Middle & latter part S. by E. moderate breezes so ends.
Latt. 23. 21. S.
Long. 48. 40. E.

Monday, Nov. the 8th/pr
Begins with moderate breezes from the S. heading S. by E. hauling. Middle part finished hauling. latter part made out steering N.
Latt. 23. 31. S.
Long. 49. 35. E.
Saw the Wm. Badger.

Tuesday, Nov. the 9th/pr
Begins with fresh breezes from the S. steering N. Middle part heading S. by E. under short sail. Latter part fresh breezes from S. by E. made sail. heading N. by E. saw fish harks. the Wm. Badger in sight cutting.

Wednesday, Nov. the 10th/pr
Begins with strong breezes from S. by E. heading S. by E. Middle part heading S. under short sail. Latter part light breezes made sail & looked to the S. by E. saw pumps. the water employed in coopers Oib. so ends. 23. 23.
