Wednesday Jan. the 26th 1853
 Begins with fresh breezes from the S.W. heading S. by E.
 Middle part strong breeze & rain took in top gall. sail
 & double reefed the top sails. latter part strong gale
 & rain. the Sonia in sight. took in the fore & main sail
 & close reefed the top sails. No ch. Lat. 35. 29. N.
 sent down the main Royal Yard. Long. 54. 00. W.

Thursday Jan. the 27th 1853
 Begins with heavy gale from the S.W. heading S. by E.
 at 12. Mer. took in the fore top sail, fore sail & main
 top sail, heavy rain. Middle part the barometer standing
 at 28. 08. Wind S.W. heading N.W. at 11. began to
 moderate. at 4. wind S.W. kept off S.W. set close
 reefed top sails & fore sail. clear weather & strong gale.
 Lat. 35. 38. N.
 Variation 22. West. Long. 54. 20. W.
