 Changed fore top sail.

Wednesday, March the 24th / 53
 Begins with moderate breezes from the N. steering N.W. by N.
 Middle part heading N.W. under short sail. strong breeze from
 the N. latter part fresh breeze from the N.W. under
 sail steering N.W. by N. changed main top gillt. sail.
 Lett. 32. 35. S.
 Changed main top gillt. sail. Long. 111. 20. E.

Thursday, March the 25th / 53
 Begins with moderate breezes from the N.W. steering
 N.W. by N. Middle part heading N. under short sail. wind S.W.
 light breeze. latter part wide sail steering N. Painted the
 waist boat, & changed jib.
