Begins with calm weather, Middle part strong breeze from N.W. heading S. under short sail latter part strong gale from the S. heading S.W. at 11. recast ship to the N.W. second.

Begins with strong gale from the S. heading N.W. under short sail, latter part the same. saw fin backs.

Tuesday, May the 24/59.

Begins with strong breeze from S.W. heading S.W. saw two, sail, at sun set, spoke the Janie, 500 lbs spinnaker. latter more moderate saw fin backs. the cooper, employed in setting up shoaks.

 Long. 107. 54 E.

Spoke the Gipsy & St. Peter.

Wednesday, May the 25/59.

Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. heading S.W. three sail in sight. at 4. Spoke the Bark Gipsy & St. Peter. 100 lbs Middle part longer short sail. latter part. Made sail two feet in sight.

 Long. 107. 20 E.
 Saw two sail

Thursday, May the 26/59.

Begins with fresh breeze from the S. heading N.W. the Gipsy in sight. Middle part heading S. strong breeze latter part strong gale from the S.E. at 10. recast ship to the S.W.
 Lett. 24. 12 S.
 Long. 107. 29 E.

Friday, May the 27/59.

Begins with strong gale from the S.E. heading S.W. under short sail Middle & latter part the same. saw fin backs.
 Lett. 24. 38 S.
 Long. 107. 04 E.

Saturday, May the 28/59.

Begins with strong breeze heading S.W. under short sail. Middle part S.W. latter more moderate Made sail heading S.W. saw many fin backs.
 Lett. 24. 30 S.
 Long. 106. 53 E.
