 Begins with fresh trades, heading S.W. by S. Middle
 part S.W. latter part strong breeze took on top galls
 sail & double reefed the top sail, saw few birds.

Tuesday, Sept. the 27th 1853
 Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. heading
 S.W. under easy sail, at 6. hauled to the S.W. saw one sail
 steering S.W. by Middle & latter part heading S.W. so on.

 Long. 106. 50. W.
 Saw one sail.
 Saw a boat to the east.

Wednesday, Sept. 28th 1853
 Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. heading S.W.
 under double reefed top sail & bower jib & sprinker.
 Middle part heading S.W. latter part more moderate made
 sail & secured to the S.W. so on.

Thursday, Sept. the 29th 1853
 Begins with fresh breezes from the S.E. heading S.W.
 Middle & latter part strong breeze, double reefed the top sail
 so on.

Friday, Sept. the 30th 1853
 Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. heading
 S.W. under double reefed top sail, bower jib & sprinker.
 Middle part heading S.W. by S. under three reefed top sail, fore
 sail & spinnaker. latter part S.W. set the main sail.

 Long. 108. 10. W.

Breising, off New Holland, October 1853.

Saturday, October 2nd 1853
 Begins with strong gale from the S.E. heading S.W. by S.
 with all necessary sail set. Middle part heading S.W. by S. under
 short sail, latter part more moderate secured to the
 S.W. & made sail.

Lat. 24. 37. S.
 Long. 108. 20. E.

Sunday, Oct. the 3rd 1853
 Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. heading
 S.W. under double reefed top sail, bower jib & sprinker.
 Middle part under short sail. Wind S. heading S.W. latter part
 moderate. Made sail, for few birds & jumpers, so on.

Lat. 24. 20. S.
 Long. 109. 20. E.

Monday, Oct. 4th 1853
 Begins with fresh breezes from the S. heading S.W. Middle
 part light breezes from S.W. heading S.E. under short sail.
 latter part light breezes from the W. made sail, steering S.
 saw few birds, so on.

Lat. 24. 58. S.
 Long. 109. 40. E.

Tuesday, Oct. the 5th 1853
 Begins with light breezes from the W. steering S.
 Middle part under short sail. latter part made sail, steering
 S.W. so on.

Lat. 25. 48. S.
 Long. 109. 55. E.

Spoke the Brig. Helen.

Wednesday, Oct. the 5th 1853
 Begins with fresh breezes from W.W. steering S.W.
 Middle part heading S.W. under short sail, latter part made
 sail heading S. saw hump backs. spoke the Eng. ship brig
 Helen, left last, from Port Gregory, for Singapore.
