

Cruising in the North Atlantic Ocean
Sunday Sept-8-1878

This day am fair weather strong
E. East wind ship working to
the windward after the whales
but did not gain any on them
two sails in sight at Sun
down shortened sail, latter
parts thick weather with rain
squalls took in the fore sail &
fore top sail closed the main
hoor two on the stack three
sails in sight No. Obs

Monday Sept-9-1878

This day am blowing a moderate
breeze from the South & ship
hoor two on the stack under
short sail at three hour shifted
to the N. W. more moderate with
some rain nothing in sight
mist parts much the same latter parts
strong breeze from the West & ship
beating to the East & employed
Boatmen out one sail in sight

(Lat 37-17 N
Long 35-34 W)

Tuesday Sept-10-1878

This day am fine weather ship at
evening the compass employed doing
ordinary ships duty on board one
sail in sight at 5 P.M. steering
N. E. at Sun pulled the main
sail and stayed up for the night
latter parts thick heavy stormy
North wind ship on the East &
Tack employed doing necessary
work on board nothing in sight

(Lat 38.03 N
Long 34.18 W)

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Wednesday Sept-11-1878

This day am breezing in and
suddenly took in sail and hove
two on the stack blowing
a moderate breeze and heavy squalls
from the North & mist parts
blowing heavy from the North
Ship hove two on the stack
Tack latter parts more moderate
but heavy swell ship hove two on
the stack

(Lat 37.40 N
Long 34.24 W)

Thursday Sept-12-1878

This day am more moderate with
heavy swell went around on the
port tack and made all prudent
sail the weather still looking bad
one sail in sight latter parts
fine weather and calm made all
sail employed doing ordinary ships
duty on board one sail in sight

(Lat 37.24 N

Friday Sept-13-1878

This day am calm with some rain
employed doing necessary work on
board one sail in sight at Sun
down took in light sails calm
latter parts fine weather light
breeze from the E. East ship on the
wind in the Eastern Tack with
all sail set employed doing ordinary
ships duty on board two sails
in sight
