Friday Sept. 20, 1898

This day fine weather light breeze from the South. Ship on the wind heading in toward the Isle employed doing ordinary Ships duty on board several sails in sight, at seven sent on the other tack, latter parts thick & Rainy Ship within 15 miles of Fayal light baffling winds not much doing on board nothing in sight

Saturday Sept. 21, 1898

This day fine weather light winds from opposite Pointe Ste Marie O. E. East employed doing ordinary Ships duty on board three sails in sight, latter parts fine weather light wind from the East & Ship on the South. The Isle in sight several sails in sight the whole Ship Nigard about five miles away off and on the Isle, (Lat 37.46 N
Long 28.54 W)

Sunday Sept. 22, 1898

This day fine weather moderate winds from the East & Ship on the wind heading to the S. E. with all sail set several sails in sight nothing doing on board latter parts fine weather strong breeze from the East & Ship heading to the S. E. with all sail set three sails in sight doing ordinary Ships duty on board, (Lat 37.12 N
Long 27.26 W)

Ship Bound South in the Atlantic Ocean

Monday Sept. 23, 1898

This day fine weather strong East wind Ship heading to the S. E. with all sail set employed doing ordinary Ships duty on board two sails in sight (Lat 37.20 N
Long 26.03, W)

Tuesday Sept. 24, 1898

This day fine weather strong wind from the East & Ship close hauled on the wind to the South & employed doing ordinary Ships duty on board nothing in sight latter parts fine weather moderate winds from the East & Ship close hauled to the S. E. with all sail set employed Boasting out mast & Boasting nothing in sight

Wednesday Sept. 25, 1898

This day fine weather strong wind from the East & Ship on the wind heading to the S. E. with all sail set employed doing ordinary Ships duty on board nothing in sight latter parts fine weather moderate breeze from the East & Ship steering to the South & doing odd jobs on board nothing in sight
