Sunday Oct. 27, 1878

This day fine weather with moderate winds from the South. Ship working South nothing doing on board. Nothing in sight. (Lat. 34° 40' N Long. 22° 05' W)

Monday Oct. 28, 1878

This day fine light air and squally ship close hauled. The S. & N. employed during ordinary ship's duty on board. Two sails in sight. (Lat. 34° 40' N Long. 22° 05' W)

Tuesday Oct. 29, 1878

This day fine light baffling winds and squally ship working South employed during ordinary ship's duty on board. One sail in sight. (Lat. 34° 40' N Long. 22° 05' W)

Wednesday Oct. 30, 1878

This day fine light baffling winds and squally ship close hauled on the wind to the S. & N. doing mess on board. Two sails in sight. (Lat. 34° 40' N Long. 22° 05' W)

Thursday Oct. 31, 1878

This day fine moderate winds but baffling ship close hauled on the wind to the S. & N. employed during ship's duty on board. One sail in sight. (Lat. 34° 40' N Long. 22° 05' W)
