Monday Nov. 25-1891

This day fine thick fog strong breeze from the N. W. Ship and sparrels back cutting in light
 Lost sight thick fog weather
 wind from N. W. to S. E. and
 Rain, No. Obs

Tuesday Nov. 26-1891

This day fine thick weather and fog with sun rose a little
 whole toward four boats
 struck to the S. West the whale
 sign to the windward struck
 there to the S. West the weather
 being thick the lines parted
 and lost the whale boats came
 on board, mist part thick and
 Rain ship under two reef top sail
 latter part thick fog strong breeze
 from the N. ship in sparrels back
 No. Obs

Wednesday Nov. 27-1891

This day fine thick fog and
 Rainy strong breeze from N. W.
 N. W. ship in sparrels back
 under short sail at five P. M.
 lit up a little nothing in sight
 latter part thick fog strong
 breeze from the N. W. ship
 and off to the N. W. three
 hours commenced to breeze on
 came to and the port back
 nothing in sight No. Obs

Ship Cruising in the S. A. Ocean

Thursday Nov. 28-1891

This day fine blowing strong
 breeze from the S. E. ship and
 in the port back took in fore
 top sail and closed reef the main
 Laying two and three blowing
 a moderate Gale mist part what
 the same latter part strong
 breeze from the S. E. ship under
 two close reef top sails heading
 to the N. E. nothing in sight
 but fine back (Lat 35-18 S
 Long 24-20 W)

Friday Nov. 29-1891

This day fine blowing strong from
 the S. E. ship under two close
 reef top sails heading to the N. E.
 nothing on board but ships still
 nothing in sight but fine back
 mist part much the same latter
 part strong wind from the S. E.
 ship under close reef top sails
 empty getting out water nothing
 in sight but fine back (Lat 35-08 S
 Long 24-33 W)

Saturday Nov. 30-1891

This day fine clouds with a
 strong breeze from the East
 ship under all pendant sail
 searching for whales during order
 of in board nothing in sight
 but fine back, mist part strong
 East wind ship under short sail
 latter part strong East wind
 and thick ship under all
 pendant sail nothing in sight
 but fine back (Lat 35-27 S
 Long 24-43 W)
