

Ship off and on the Isle of St Helena

Wednesday April 9, 1879
This day calm fine weather Ship
Laying off and on the Boat came
off But the Capt. Stopped on Shore
Then I stood off Shore, three Ships
off the Isle, Wind & latter
Parts strong breeze and squally
Ship off and on the Isle at
even P.M. sent a Boat on
Shore after the Capt.

Thursday April 10, 1879
This day calm strong Breezes &
Squally at four A.M. the Capt.
came off. Then I stood off
Shore with the Ship. several
Sails in Sight, Wind & latter
Parts strong breeze & squally
Ship Cruising off the Isle &
Several Sails in Sight

Friday April 11, 1879
This day calm squally & strong
breeze Ship Cruising off the Isle
Several sails in Sight latter
Part thick squally went in
to Anchor came to anchor at
11 P.M. in 23 fathoms of Water
employed doing ordinary Ship
work on board.

Ship in St Helena Harbor

Saturday April 12, 1879
This day calm Ship to anchor
in Port employed doing ordinary
work on board latter Part
employed doing ordinary Ship duty

Sunday April 13, 1879
This day calm Ship in Port employed
Painting a little several Ship
in Port, Wind Part on watch
ashore, latter Part nothing doing
on board the harbor came in
to anchor on watch ashore

Monday April 14, 1879
This day in Port nothing doing on
board on watch on Shore,
Wind Part on watch on Shore
latter Part in Port employed
Painting setting up Mast Gears
Anchors Bombs & Scurter

Tuesday April 15, 1879
This day in Port employed doing necessary
work on board, Wind Part
on watch on Shore, latter Part
in Port employed Painting Ship out
sides and other jobs.
