Sunday April 27. 1829
Ship in Port emp getting

board 200 barrels of water

Run ashore nothing doing on
board

Monday April 28. 1829
Ship in Port nothing doing
in board Latter Part emp
Stowing Casks for water and
taking some Stores on board

Tuesday April 29.
Ship in Port emp Stowing
off between deck the Cape
Steamer arrived to day
Three Whalers off on the Harbor
Incl Part one man Antares Bombard
Disengaged Latter Part one watch
on Liberty emp setting up shooks

Wednesday April 30. 1829
This day Ship in Port one watch
on Liberty emp doing messary work
and getting Ready for Sea
Latter Part one watch on Liberty
emp took on board some Stores

This day in Port one watch on

in board, Latter Part one

80 barrels of water,

Friday May 2. 1829
This day in Port emp

one watch on Shore on Liberty

Saturday May 3. 1829
Ship in Port one watch on
Liberty Latter Part in watch on
Liberty emp doing messary work
on board the Niger & Catalpa
Sail to day,

Sunday May 4. 1829
Ship in Port one watch ashore
on Liberty Latter Part nothing doing
in board one watch on Liberty

Monday May 5. 1829
This day nothing doing on board
one watch on Liberty at day light
all Hands in board getting ready
for Sea
