Monday May 18, 1879

This day fine weather moderate breeze ship by the wind and the tack nothing in sight, mid part much the same, latter part moderate breeze ship by the wind and the tack, nothing doing on board nothing in sight

(Lat. 9 = 28° N
(Long. 7 = 58° E

Tuesday May 19, 1879

This day fine weather with a moderate breeze ship by the wind and the tack, nothing in sight, mid part much the same, latter part light breeze ship by the wind and the tack, employed repairing the fore top sail, nothing in sight (No Ob)

Wednesday May 20, 1879

This day fine weather finished the top sail and bent it, nothing in sight, latter part fine weather light breeze ship in the west tack, employed at work in the Rigging, nothing in sight

(Lat. 9 = 38° N
(Long. 9 = 56° E

Ship Cruising in The Coast

Wednesday May 21, 1879

This day fine light breeze ship in the west tack, employed at work in the Rigging, Rose new falls to the two quarter boats, nothing in sight, mid part much the same, latter part fine weather light breeze ship looking to the South, set all sail, set up ordinary ship duty on board, nothing in sight

(Lat. 10 = 12° N
(Long. 9 = 48° E

Thursday May 22, 1879

This day fine fine weather light breeze ship in opposite tacks, looking to the South, set nothing in sight, mid part, about the same, latter part fine weather moderate breeze ship and landed the bark Moss sail, taking 25° Sperm since leaving St Helena

(Lat. 10 = 28° S
(Long. 10 = 39° E

Friday March 23, 79

This day fine weather the ship in company, nothing in sight, mid part moderate breeze, latter part fine weather light breeze ship looking to the South, set up repaired the fore sail and bent it again, nothing in sight

(Lat. 10 = 40° S
(Long. 10 = 56° E
