Ship Lying to Anchor on the Coast

Thursday June 12, 1879
This day wind strong breeze
four Boats off cruising
One of us with fourth Officer
went ashore and left the
Ship and sent the Boat and
cared, nothing in sight, latter
part at daylight four Boats off
cruising for Humpbacks, saw
two Whales going quick but did
not strike

Friday June 13, 1879
This day four Boats off cruising
strong breeze, saw no Whales
Boats came on board at sun
down, latter part at daylight
four Boats off cruising but saw
nothing

Saturday June 14, 1879
This day strong breeze four
Boats off cruising but saw
nothing, Boats came on board
at sun down, latter part
three Boats down cruising got
the Ship, unelap (wax) and
flew down about three
miles saw two Whales and
chased them, Ship came
to anchor in 17 fathoms
of water

Ship at Anchor on the Coast

Sunday June 15, 1879
This day three Boats chasing
Whales, struck to the S. Boat
the whale went off shore the
line parted the whale went off
Boats came on board at ten
a.m. latter part light
breeze four Boats off cruising
but saw nothing

Monday June 16, 1879
This day light breeze four
Boats off saw two Whales
going quick but did not
strike, Boats came on board
at sun down, latter part at
daylight four Boats off cruising
saw nothing

Tuesday June 17, 1879
This day light breeze four Boats
off cruising but saw nothing
Boats came on board at sun
down, latter part light breeze
and calm three Boats off cruising
nothing in sight

Wednesday June 18, 1879
This day three Boats down
cruising saw nothing excepting
the S. Boat on board Boats
came on board at sun down
latter part at daylight four
Boats off cruising saw nothing
saw one whale from the Ship
