Wednesday Aug. 20, 1879
This day light S. E. Wind
Ship heading to the West
with all sail set emp. Repairing
the Boat and getting
ready for Offshore whaling
at Sun down took in light
Sails and came to this point
Mid. & Latter Part light
Southly Wind Ship on the
Stuck emp. Beaking out order
and Repairing the Boat. Lat 4, 29
(Long 10 = 15)

Thursday Aug. 21, 1879
This day light breeze
Ship on the Stuck with
all sail set nothing in
sight emp. cutting new Whales
lines & Repairing the Boat
Latter Part light breeze Ship
on the Wind and the Stuck
emp. fix up the Boat and
cutting new lines. (No. 66)

Friday Aug. 22, 1879
This day light breeze
Ship on the Stuck finished
the Boat and Part had
out nothing in sight Latter
Part fine weather light breeze
Ship on the Stuck employed
washing Ship nothing in
sight (Lat 5 = 14, S
(Long 9 = 48 E)

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Saturday Aug. 23, 1879
This day fine weather
light breeze Ship heading
to the S. E. finished washing
Ship nothing in sight Mid
Part light breeze Latter Part
Hazy light breeze Ship on the
in shore tack nothing in sight
Bent Fore Top Sail (Lat 5 = 18 S
(Long 9 = 48 E)

Sunday Aug. 24, 1879
This day light breeze Ship
on the in shore tack Bent
new main Top Sail have run
Running down and other jobs
in repair, Mid Part about the
same Latter Part moderate
breeze Ship heading to the
S. East nothing doing on board
(Lat 5 = 40 S
(Long 10 = 36 E)

Monday Aug. 25, 1879
This day fine weather light
breeze from the South Ship
on the Stuck nothing in
sight nothing doing on board
Latter Part much light breeze
Ship on the Western tack
employed washing Ship out side
and working about the Rig in
nothing in sight
(Lat 5 = 18 S
(Long 10 = 13 E)
