Tuesday Oct. 7, 1879

This day Ship in Port took on

Shore emp. Painting Ship
the Bark Sun Beam in
sight the Gulf came in
with a Boat,

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Wednesday Oct. 8, 1879

This day Ship in Port
finishing Painting in field
the watch came off at
Sun down. Mid Plant the
Bark Sun Beam in the anchor.

my watch on Shore the
Bark President came in to
Anchor.

Thursday Oct. 9, 1879

This day in Port my watch
on Shore employed doing odd jobs
on board. All Hands on board
