Sunday Oct. 12, '79

This day in Port one watch on shore, one boat after wood took on board from B.K. Petrel two small Casks of Breach. Latter Part one watch on shore nothing doing on board.

Monday Oct. 13, '79

This day in Port one watch on shore all hands on board at Sun down. Latter Part emp. Brea being out oil.

This day emp. stowing back the ground and getting Ready to ship oil. Latter Part Shipper 100 Bbl. on board the L. Brea sent all aft ashore after water.

Wednesday Oct. 15, '79

This day sitting up Casks took on board a Raft of water finished stowing oil. Brea the L. B. Latter Part two Boats after a Raft of water stowing out Brea flour between decks the B.K. Lamourain came in to day.

Thursday Oct. 16, '79

This day emp. stowing Casks for water took on board. Raft of water. Latter Part Running the water sent the Raft in with our Boat.

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Friday Oct. 17, '79

This day in Port emp. sitting up Casks for water and other jobs on board. Latter Part stowing the water away. The weather being and sent the Raft on shore.

This day in Port emp. sitting up Casks for water and other jobs on board. Latter Part stowing the water away. The weather being.

Sunday Oct. 19, '79

This day of Rain and Back the last Raft for water has come ashore. one Boat a shore. Sunday. Latter Part nothing on board one watch ashore.

Monday Oct. 20, '79

This day nothing on board the other watch ashore all hands on board at Sun down. Latter Part emp. Painting the Sails and getting Ready for sea. The L. Brea left for Home to day.

This day Ship to anchor all Ready for sea. L. Brea took our anchor and stood off shore on the West tack in company with the N.P. Fragier emp. stowing our Chains and securing our anchors so ready this day.
