Thursday Nov. 6, 1822

This day Calm fine weather
with a moderate breeze Ship
on the West tack forward
B. Fish but did not strike
Boats came on board two
Sails in sight. Mid Part light
breeze Latter Part light breeze from South
Ship on the Western tack with all sail
set employed doing ordinary Ships duty
on board two Sails in sight

Friday Nov. 7, 1822

This day Calm light Southerly winds
Ship on the Western tack with all sail
set employed doing odd jobs on board
two Sails in sight. Mid Part light
Southerly winds Ship on the Western tack

set one Sail in sight on the
Western tack

Saturday Nov. 8, - 22

This day Calm fine weather with a
moderate breeze from the South
Ship on the Western tack employed
doing ordinary Ships duty on board
one Sail in sight. Mid Part mod-
erate breeze Latter Part moderate
single from the South employed
Started one Cask of water one Saily
in sight
