Friday February 13th 1863

weather squally wind S.W. Ship by the wind heading S.E. with Starboard tack on board ship under south reef top sails middle part a gale of wind from S.W. to N.W. squally ship under close reef main top sail & mizen top mast staysail latter part gale moderates some wind at night with Starboard tack on board at 11 am kept the ship off S.E. W.

Saturday February 14th 1863

Strong breeze from N. ship courses S.W. heavy sea running. Cloudy. Middle part fine breeze from S.E. courses S.W. latter part weather continues fine wind the same

Lat. at noon 32° 02' N
Long at 3 p.m. 74° 37' W

Sunday February 15th 1863

weather cloudy wind S.E. Ship courses S.W. all sail set Middle and latter wind from E ship by the wind with Starboard tack on board heading South

Lat 29° 31' N
Long at 3 p.m. 75° 15' W

Monday February 16th 1863

This twenty four hours commences with light air from E ship by the wind with Starboard tack on board heading to the South with all sail set on ship in sight steering to the South Middle part weather fine light air from E ship by the wind heading S.W. latter part continues the same

Lat at 4 p.m. 28° 00' N
Long at 4 p.m. 76° 00' W

Tuesday February 17th 1863

weather fine light air from E ship by the wind with Starboard tack on board heading S.W. at 6 p.m. tacked ship heading N.E. with Starboard tack on board this twenty four hours ends with S.W. wind ship heading S.E. Lat 28° 07' N Long 76° 46' W at 4 p.m.

Barth Millenket of Dartmouth 1863

Wednesday February 18th 1863

weather fine wind light from S.E. ship by the wind heading S.E. with Starboard tack on board Middle part ship by the wind heading to the E.S.E. latter part heading to the W. employed in rigging in forenoon

Thursday February 19th 1863

weather cloudy wind S.E. ship by the wind heading to the S.W. W. employed in rigging in forenoon. Middle part ship by the wind heading to East latter part fine weather ship by the wind heading to the West. Lat 27° 35' N

Friday February 20th 1863

weather fine wind light from S.W. ship by the wind heading S.W. with Starboard tack on board middle and latter part light air from S.W. ship by the wind heading to the South East

Lat 26° 53' N
Long 73° 44' W

Saturday February 21st 1863

fine weather light air from S.W. ship by the wind heading S.E. with Starboard tack on board middle part calm latter part light air from south

Lat 26° 32' N
Long 73° 12' W

Sunday February 22nd 1863

weather fine wind light from the south middle part fine breeze from S.E. courses S.W. latter part wind from the South squally courses W. Lat 25° 22' N Long 76° 22' W
