Fresh trades and pleasant steering by the wind to the Eastward under all sail employed in fitting the foretopmast rigging &c &c.

Monday 25th 1867

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Tuesday Feb 26th 1867

Fresh trades and pleasant steering by the wind to the Eastward under all sail so near the day Lat 14.39 N Long 27.31 West

Wednesday 27th 1867

Fresh trades and pleasant steering by the wind to the S. E. under all sail lowered for Blackfish took one Lat 14.01 N Long 26.01 West

Thursday 28th 1867

Fresh trades and pleasant steering by the wind to the Northward sent up the foretopmast mizzen the Blackfish sends the day Lat 14.01 N Long 25.51

Friday 29th 1867

Light trades and pleasant steering by the wind to the Northward under all sail bent the Safftop sail so ends this day Lat 13.13 N Long 24.51 W.

Saturday 30th 1867

Light baffling trades and pleasant steering by the wind on opposite tack under all sail the watch employed in breaking out the hold saw a Bark steering to the N. Northward and Westward
