Thursday April 11th 1868

Fresh breeze and pleasant steering N by N under all sail at 4 o'clock P.M. spoke the Schooner Mary S. Curren of Provincetown Capt. Haswell 10 months out 200 Spinn Lat 16.01 N Long 50.55 W West

Friday 12th 1868

Strong breeze and rugged steering by the wind to the Northward all sail set in company with the Mary S. Curren so ends the day
Lat 15.18 N Long 50.39 W West

Saturday 13th 1868

Strong breeze and rugged by the wind to the S. E. under easy sail saw a brig steering to the N. W. thus ends this day
Lat 15.54 N Long 50.21 W NW

Sunday 14th 1868

Fresh breeze and squally with some rain by the Wind to the Northward under short sail nothing in sight Lat 15.27 Long 50.00 W West

Monday 15th 1868

Strong breeze and rugged with some rain by the wind to the S. E. saw one sail
Latitude 15.55 W Longitude

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Tuesday April 16th 1868

Fresh breeze and pleasant steering by the wind to the W. E. all sail set
Latitude 14.54 N Longitude 48.44 W

Wednesday 17th 1868

Strong breeze and rugged steering N. N. W. by Compass under easy sail nothing in sight Lat 15.20 N Long 50.32 W

Thursday 18th 1868

Fresh breeze with some rain steering N. N. W. under easy sail at 12 M. wore ship and steered N. W. Set up the Fore rigging
Lat 16.11 N Long 51.28 West

Friday 19th 1868

Fresh breeze and pleasant steering N. E. W. by compass under easy sail at 2 o'clock P.M. wore ship steered W. E. W. nothing in sight
Latitude 16.23 W Longitude 52.34 West

Saturday 20th 1868

Light breeze and pleasant steering by the wind on opposite tacks saw nothing this day
