Sunday April 21st 1867
Bright breeze and pleasant weather laying to under short sail heading to the Northward and eastward Lat 15° 43' N Long 55° 20' W.

Monday 22nd 1867
Fresh breeze and pleasant steering by the wind to the S. E. all sail set saw 2 sails steering to the N. W. employed in breaking out water shifting it 8 or 9
Latitude 16° 34' N Longitude 57° 08' W.

Tuesday 23rd 1867
Bright breeze and pleasant at daylight kept of W. N. W. all sail set nothing in sight Lat 16° 08' N. Long 57° 28' West

Wednesday 24th 1867
Bright breeze and pleasant steering W. S. W. all sail set lowered for blackfish took three
Latitude 16° 22' N. Longitude 57° 04' West

Thursday 25th 1867
Light breeze from C. E. and fine pleasant weather steering by the wind to the southward all sail set saw porpoises mined blackfish so ends this day
Lat 15° 13' North Long 54° 23' West

Friday 26th 1867
Bright breeze from the eastward and fine pleasant weather steering W. N. W. by compass Lat 14° 53' N Long 53° 21' West

Saturday 27th 1867
Fine pleasant weather with a light breeze from the eastward steering by with all sail set saw two sails steering to the Westward

Sunday 28th 1867
Light airs from the Eastward and pleasant steering W. by N. under short sail nothing in sight Latitude 14° 25' North

Monday 29th 1867
Bright breeze and from the Eastward and pleasant steering S. W. by Compass under all sail Lat 13° 31' N Long 57° 32' West

Tuesday 30th 1867
Bright breeze and pleasant steering W. S. W. at 8 o'clock ^{A.M.} raised the Island of Barbados right ahead bearing W. S. W. distant about thirty miles at sunset stood off shore under short sail so ends this day
