Friday May 10th 1867

Took on board 14 bunches of Bananas and 1¹/₂ dozen Pine Apples two baskets of limes George Trall Cummings - Newman and the Steward who went on shore Wednesday eve have not yet returned with the exception of the Steward who came on board this evening sent on shore 1 barrel of Oil and 1 bbl Beef

Saturday 11th 1867

At 9 o'clock A. M. took our anchor and stood out for sea all hands on board except three ^{men} who deserted. One passenger on board for Roussau

Sunday 12th 1867

Off and on at the port of Roussau at 4 o'clock A. M. the Captain went ashore with the passenger from Prince Rupert at 8 o'clock the Capt. returned without the deserters who were reported about 5 miles out in the country one of them sick saw several small vessels and one steamer after hoisting the boat wore round and headed of shore under short sail

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Monday 13th 1867

All this day of and on at the port Roussau waiting for the capture of our deserters whom the Police are in search of at 8 o'clock P. M. the boat returned with all except a Boatsteerer who went out in search with the police and had not yet returned so ends this day

Tuesday 14th 1867

Off and on at the port of Roussau at about 10 o'clock P. M. sent in a boat which returned with two of the deserters Chat Cummings and George Trall together with the Police and the Boatsteerer that went in search of them after taking them aboard and landing the Police steered N W and made all sail

Wednesday 15th 1867

Light air and pleasant Steering N W Employed in washing inside and cleaning iron the Island of Gaudaloupe in sight saw one sail to the south ward
