Light airs from the Northward and pleasant weather steering S.W. by compass under all sail Saw Blackfish and Grampass Albert Lynn came to duty has been off duty since the 27th of May Jules Humbert of duty with a broken finger Lat 32.24 N Long 52.02 W

Sunday 11th 1867

All this day very light airs from N.E. with calms laying under short sail heading to the Eastward Lat 32.24 N

Monday 12th 1867

Light airs from the southward and calms heading to the Southward by the wind all sail set at 32.27 N Long 52.03 W

Tuesday 13th 1867

Wind from the Eastward and pleasant steering to the Northward under all sail in company with the Susan N. Smith of Boston Capt Cook. No Observation

Thursday 15th 1867

Fresh breeze from S.E. and pleasant steering E.N.E. by compass under all sail No Obs.

Friday 16th 1867

Light breeze and pleasant steering by the wind to the Northward until 12 M. then tacked to the Eastward saw one sail
Latitude 35.35 Longitude 50.18 West

Saturday 17th 1867

Light airs and calms working to the Eastward under all sail nothing in sight this day
Lat 35.02 N Long 50.14 W

Sunday 18th 1867

Light airs from S.W. and pleasant steering E.S.E. by compass at 2 o'clock P.M. raised a Bark to leeward waiting at 3 o'clock saw the whale lowered and chased until sunset without success so ends this day
Lat 36.17 N Long 49.24 W
