Monday 19th 1867 Aug.

Light breeze from S.W. and fine pleasant weather
steering C. F. C. by compass saw three sails
employed in repairing the gammon strap foremast
Lat 36° 00' N Long 48° 45' W

Tuesday 20th 1867

Light breeze from S.W. and pleasant steering
C. F. C. by compass saw four sails gamed with
the sch. J. A. Lewis of Provincetown
Lat 35° 57' North Long 49° 37' West

Wednesday 21st 1867

Fresh breeze from S.W. with some rain steering E.
S. E. by compass saw two sails steering to the Eastward
Ran out new Foresail and gab

Thursday 22nd 1867

Light breeze from the Westward and pleasant
steering C. F. C. Compass under all sail at
8 o'clock raised a Sperm Whale going quick
to the west N. W. It overed and chased until 11 o'clock
and gave up the chase came on board and made
all sail and stood to the S. W. and at 10 o'clock
gave up the chase and steered C. F. C. again
the Whale being out of sight
Spoke the Sch. B. H. Crocker of Provincetown

Friday 23rd Aug 1867

Light breeze from the Westward and fine pleasant
weather steering by the wind on opposite tacks
under all sail at 10 o'clock P. M. gamed with
the Brig Eunice W. Adams of Mantucket
and saw several other sails
Lat 36° 09' N Long 44° 30' W

Saturday 24th 1867

Fresh breeze from the Westward and fine
pleasant weather steering by the wind on
opposite tacks under all sail saw three S.

Sunday 25th 1867

Light airs and calms Laying to under
short sail heading to the Northward four
sails in sight Lat 36° 05' N Long 44° 31' W

Monday 26th 1867

All this day lay becalmed three sails in sight
employed in fitting over our new fore sail
Latitude 36° 03' N Longitude 44° 03' W

Tuesday 27th 1867

All this day lay becalmed three sails in
sight saw Transpasser's records this day
Lat 35° 49' North
