Wednesday 28th 1867

Squally with rain and rugged employed in Boulding and cutting the head at 1 o'clock lashed down

Thursday 29th 1867

Squally rugged and rain took in the gunk and Bailed the case cooled down on account of rain saw several sails No Observation Sun obscured

Friday 29th 1867

Light breeze from the N. E. and rugged employed in Boulding and cutting gunk at 5 o'clock P. M. Boulding and put on the fat lean
Lat 05:18 North No Long

Saturday 29th 1867

Frost and Middle parts fine pleasant weather with a light breeze from the N. E. Latter part wind from E. W. and rainy all hands employed in stowing down and clearing up the decks 2:00 p.m. finished and washed off the decks Lat 05:02 N Long

Sunday 29th 1867

Light breeze from the N. E. with rainy squally weather. Steering to under short sail
Lat 05:10 North Long 21:53 West

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Monday Dec 30th 1867

Light breeze from the Eastward and fine pleasant weather steering to the Southward and Eastward under all sail. saw one sail steering to the southward. Employed in grinding craft and fitting spades, so ends the day
Lat 05:40 North Long unknown

Tuesday 31st 1867

Light breeze and pleasant steering to the Southward and Westward, under all sail and sailed 4 barrels of Whicorez so ends the day
Lat 06:22 North Long 21:52 West

Jan 1st 1868

Wednesday 31st 1867

Strong breeze from the Eastward and rugged steering by the wind on opposite tacks under easy sail. No observation sun obscured

Thursday 31st 1867

Drizzling winds from the N. E. and rainy steering by the wind under all sail. saw a whaling bark steering to the N. W. employed in repairing the Gaff top sail
Lat 05:20 North
