Thursday Feb 20th 1868

Strong breeze and rough by the wind to the Northward under short sail nothing in sight - Latitude 13.21 North Longitude 37.27 West

Friday 21st 1868

Strong Trades and rough steering by the wind on opposite tack. Under short sail saw Blackfish lowered one boat but without success Lat 13.01 N. Long 37.29 North

Saturday 22nd 1868

Light breeze and pleasant steering by the wind to the Northward under all sail spoke the Schr. J. M. Dodge of New Bedford, Capt. Clark Lat 13.10 N Long 37.26 W

Sunday 23rd 1868

Light breeze and fine pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Northward under short sail. J. M. Dodge in sight and another sail to the W.

Monday 24th 1868

Light breeze and fine pleasant weather by the wind to the N. E. under all sail saw a merchant ship steering to the Northward spoke the Schr. Admiral H. Blake of Marion Capt. Hammond 1100 Tonnage Lat 13.38 N Long 37.10 West

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Tuesday Feb 25th 1868

Fresh breeze and shuky weather steering by the wind under short sail nothing in sight Lat 12.58 North Long 37.10 West

Wednesday 26th 1868

Light breeze and pleasant steering by the wind to the S. E. until 12 M. then tacked ship to the Northward Lat 11.42 N Long 36.59 W

Thursday 27th 1868

Fine pleasant weather with a light breeze from N. E. steering W. by N all sail set. Saw two sails to the Eastward called them Merchant - men saw 4 macks Lat 14.36 N Long 37.27 W

Friday 28th 1868

Light breeze from N. E. and fine pleasant weather steering to the Westward all sail set saw saw the sail to the N. E. Lat 12.31 North Long 38.23 West

Saturday 29th 1868

Light breeze from N. W. and fine pleasant weather steering S. W. by compass under all sail saw 4 macks and a bark steering N. W. Lat 11.31 North N Long 38.27 West
