Fresh breeze and pleasant steering W. by
compass under short sail exchanged Longit-
udes with Bark William Jones of Newport
England differer in Long 8 1/2 miles

Wednesday 18th 1868

Light airs and calmy on opposite tack by
the wind several sails in sight
Latitude 15.47 North Longitude

Thursday 19th 1868

All this day lay becalmed two sails in sight
Latitude 15.33 North Longitude 50.42 W

Friday 20th 1868

Light breeze from the N. E. and fine pleasant
weather steering W. Looked for Blackfish
no success but sails in sight
Latitude 18.12 North Longitude 50.59 West
