Sunday 12th 1868

Fresh breeze and rugged with some rain by the wind on opposite tack under short sail Lat 15° 55' North Long 51° 25' West

Monday 13th 1868

Fresh breeze and rugged W. S. W. under easy sail spoke the Brig *E. H. Adams* of Baltimore Capt. Coleman the watch employed in getting up the rigging

Tuesday 14th 1868

Fresh breeze and pleasant steering South in company with the *E. H. Adams* the watch employed in the rigging spoke the *E. H. A.* Lat 15° 40' North Long 52° 13' West

Wednesday 15th 1868

Light breeze and fine pleasant weather steering different courses to the Westward the *E. H. A.* in sight watch employed in the rigging ends the day Lat 13° 35' North Long 53° 00' West

Thursday 16th 1868

Light breeze and fine weather steering S W all sail the *E. H. A.* in sight the watch employed in the rigging Lat 12° 55' North Long 53° 23' West

Friday April 18th 1868

Light breeze from the N. E. and fine pleasant weather steering to the Westward on different courses in company with the Brig *E. H. Adams* saw a Bark steering to the Westward Lat 12° 35' North Long 54° 32' West

Saturday 18th 1868

Fresh breeze and fine pleasant weather steering to the westward on different courses named with the *E. H. Adams* so ends the day Lat 12° 20' North Long 55° 31' West

Sunday 19th 1868

Fresh breeze and fine pleasant weather steering W by compass in company with the *E. H. A.* another sail in sight steering the same Lat 12° 41' North Long 57° 31' West

Monday 20th 1868

Strong breeze and rugged steering West under easy sail several sails in sight Lat 13° 31' North Long 55° 51' West

Tuesday 21st 1868

Strong breeze and rugged steering W. S. W. at 1 o'clock raised the Island of Barbados at 4 o'clock came to an anchor.
