Friday May 15th 1868

Fresh breeze and fine pleasant weather steering by the wind on opposite tacks under easy sail the Island of Sombrero in sight bearing S by W distant 8 miles. saw one sail steering to the Westward

Saturday 16th 1868

Fresh breeze and fine pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Northward under easy sail saw one sail

Sunday 17th 1868

Light breeze and fine pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Northward under all sail saw a sail to the Southward

Monday 18th 1868

Light breeze and fine pleasant weather by the wind to the N.E. under all sail

Tuesday 19th 1868

Fine pleasant weather with a light breeze from steering by the wind to the N.E. under all sail Lat 22.48 N. Long 62.12 W.

Wednesday 20th 1868

Strong breeze and rugged steering N.E. by N under all sail nothing in sight this day

Fresh breeze and rugged steering N.E. by N under all sail. nothing in sight this day

Friday 22nd 1868

Fresh breeze and fine pleasant weather steering N.E. by N under easy sail Lat 28.37 North Long 59.11 West

Saturday 23rd 1868

Fresh breeze and fine pleasant weather steering N.N.E. under all sail, nothing in sight

Sunday 24th 1868

Light breeze from the Eastward with fine pleasant weather laying by the wind under short sail heading to the N.E. nothing in sight Lat 30.27 North Longitude 58.27 West

Monday 26th 1868

Light air inclining to calms working to the eastward sent a boat on board of the Schooner Wentworth of Boston Capt. Adams 11 days from Norfolk for Demarara saw another sail. Lat 30.41 North Long 57.35 West
