Tuesday 26th May 1868

Light air and calm, employed in setting up rigging. Four sails in sight so ends the day

Wednesday 27th 1868

Light breeze from South and fine pleasant weather steering N under easy sail. saw two sails Lat 31° 53' North Long 57° 24' West

Thursday 28th 1868

Steering N.E. under easy sail with a light breeze a fine pleasant weather saw two sails

Friday 29th 1868

Light breeze and fine pleasant weather steering by the wind on opposite tack under easy sail saw a schooner steering to the S.W. Latitude 32° 24' North Longitude 58° 45' West

Saturday 30th 1868

Light breeze from S. with fine pleasant weather steering by the wind on opposite tack under all sail saw one sail steering to the S.E.

Sunday 31st 1868

Light breeze from S. and fine pleasant weather laying by the wind heading to the S.E. Saw a heading to the S.E. Latitude 32° 28' North

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Monday June 1st 1868

Fine pleasant weather with a light breeze from the Southward steering by the wind on opposite saw two whalers at Bark and Schooner steering to the S.E.

Tuesday 2nd 1868

Fresh breeze and fine pleasant weather steering by the wind to the S.E. under easy sail saw a Brig steering to the N.E. No Observation

Wednesday 3rd 1868

Light breeze from the Southward and fine pleasant weather steering S.E. under easy sail saw a Brig steering to the S.E. Lat 32° 15' North Long 58° 44' West

Thursday 4th 1868

Light breeze from S.W. with fine pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Southward under all sail saw two sails whalers steering to the N.E. Lat 31° 51' N Long 52° 56' W

Friday 5th 1868

First and middle part of this day calm Lat part light air from North steering S.W. under easy sail one sail in sight
