Thursday June 18th 1868

Light airs from the Westward inclining to calm, working to the eastward under all sail. Saw a Bark to the Westward.

Friday 19th 1868

Strong breeze from S. W. and rainy steering S. W. by E. under easy sail.
Lat 32° 15' North Long 35° 45' West.

Saturday 20th 1868

All this day steering S. W. by E. with a light breeze from the westward and fine pleasant weather saw one sail to the S. E.
Lat 31° 34' North Long 34° 04' West.

Sunday 21st 1868

Light airs from the Westward and fine pleasant weather steering S. E. by E. under sheet sail. Nothing in sight so ends the day.
Lat 31° 33' North Long 33° 55' West.

Monday 22nd 1868

Light airs and fine pleasant weather steering S. E. by E. under all sail. Lowered for blackfish and took one so ends the day.

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Tuesday 23rd June 1868

Light airs from the Westward and fine pleasant weather steering S. E. by E. under all sail.

Wednesday 24th 1868

Light airs from the S. W. and rainy steering by Compass S. E. by E. under easy sail. Nothing in sight.
Lat 31° 28' North Long 31° 10' West.

Thursday 25th 1868

All of this day a calm for Schooners in sight took in our Stern Boat and fitted new Stern Bearer in place of the old one.
Lat 31° 09' N. Long 30° 57' W.

Friday 26th 1868

Light airs from the westward and fine pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Northward under all sail saw one sail to the S. E.
Lat 31° 09' North Long 30° 55' West.

Saturday 27th 1868

Light breeze from the N. E. and fine pleasant weather steering S. E. under all sail. Spoke the Brig H. K. Mize of Boston. Capt Wood & crew all clean.
