So ends this day Lat 16-40 Long 82-52

Tuesday April 11<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes from  
the East men employed in the ships  
duties So ends this day Lat 16-53 Long 82-49

Wednesday April 12<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes from  
the East at daylight made sail at  
7 A.M. saw blackfish herd and got  
six so ends this day Lat 17-02 Long 82-15

Thursday April 13<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours moderate breezes from  
E.N.E. at daylight made sail to cruise at  
7.20 P.M. Saw blackfish herd and got four  
so ends this day Lat 17-02 Long 82-12

Friday April 14<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes from the  
East men employed missing blades so  
ends this day Lat 17-00 Long 82-20

Saturday April 15<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes from  
the East at 8. A.M. set the work again  
so ends the day Lat 16-58 Long 82-08

Sunday April 16<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours moderate breezes from the  
E.N.E. so ends these 24 hours Lat 17-04 Long 81-36

Monday April 17<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes from the  
E.N.E. men employed in the ships duties so ends  
this day Lat 16-54 Long 81-30 W

Tuesday April 18<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes with  
raies squalls at daylight made sail to  
cruise saw a barge standing toward

All these 24 hours gentle breezes with  
passing clouds men employed in the  
ships duties so ends this day Lat 16-53 Long 80-56

Thursday April 20<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 22 hours fresh breezes with  
raies squalls at sun down shortened sail  
so ends this day Lat 16-53 Long 80-56

Friday April 21<sup>st</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes from the E.N.E.  
at daylight made sail to cruise men employed in  
the ships duties at sun down shortened sail  
so ends this day Lat 16-58 Long 82-02

Saturday April 22<sup>nd</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes from the  
E.N.E. at daylight made sail to cruise  
at sun down took in sail so ends  
this day Lat 17-06 Long 83-00

Sunday April 23<sup>rd</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes from East  
gained Sect<sup>n</sup> Leuckstab so ends this day  
Lat 16-48 Long 82-54 W

Monday April 24<sup>th</sup> 1876

All these 24 hours gentle breezes from  
East at daylight made sail to cruise  
men employed in the ships duties  
so ends this day Lat Long
