

- 28 This day begins with moderate weather and fine sea finbacks at Sunset Saw Blackfish did not lower lat 23-40 lon 26-57
- 29 Moderate throughout the day Saw a number of vessels Saw finbacks wind SW lat 23-10 lon 26-09
- 30 This day begins with moderate weather and continues through the day wind from SW to SW Sent up the fore top mast board and bows lat 22-46 lon 25-20
- 31 Sunday this day begins with fine weather and moderate wind from SW to W lat 21-48 lon 24-57 at 5 pm wind started around to NE
- January the first begins with squally trades middle and latter part fine weather Saw 2 sail bent the chains lat 19-36 lon 23-04
- 2 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day at day light Saw a whaling Schooner standing to the N Saw a school of Blackfish Struck 2 lost one at 11 1/2 am Saw the Island of St. Artorn
- 3 This day begins with fresh trades and continues through the day at 1 pm Saw the Island of Brava at 3-30 came to anchor at Brava

- 4 Trades fresh broke out fore and aft on bent the new foresail and bent the old one
- 5 Trades fresh turned the Boat on ready to paint
- 6 Painted 2 Boats all hands employed in Ship's duty
- 7 Fine weather and moderate painted the quarter deck and Starboard Boat
- 8 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day fished one of the Star davitt
- 9 Fine weather gave the Quarter deck the Second Coat of Paint
- 10 Fine weather gave the Starboard Boat the Second Coat of Paint Capt went up town to Ship his men
- 11 This day begins with a fresh breeze from the S with rain middle and latter part heavy rain with thunder and lightning
- 12 Begins with heavy rain and with plenty of thunder and lightning got of 250 Pumpkins and Some Potatoes crew all Ship's and on board ready for sea
