

- 9 This day begins with calm weather middle and latter part a light breeze lat $11=43$ lon $20=49$
- 10 This day begins with a moderate breeze and continues through the day Saw Porpoises and Grampuses finished Side Sticking the trisail and took a cloth off the Stay sail lat $12=6$ lon $20=53$
- 11 This day begins with a Strong breeze and continues through the day Saw a Brig lat $13=39$ lon 22
- 12 This day begins with a Strong breeze and continues through the day Saw Porpoises lat $15=09$ lon $22=38$
- 13 Moderate breeze at 1 PM Saw the Island of Bonavista at 4 PM kept off for St Vincent
- 14 This day begins with a moderate breeze and continues through the day St Nicholas in sight all day weather Smoky
- 15 This day begins with a moderate breeze middle and latter part fresh breeze at daylight Saw the Island of St Antonio at 10 AM came to anchor at St Vincent went the new mainsail and bent the old one Scaped and Flushed down the fore and main mast

- 16 Fine weather Scaped the grain boom and ciled it on bent the fly jib and gaff topsail for repairs Set up the flying jib they let go the Port anchor
- 17 Fine weather bent gaff topsail and flying jib all hands employed in Ships duty
- 18 Breeze fine weather fresh breeze one man run away
- 19 Fine weather done some painting the allone came in last night repaired jib Sheet Block's sent main hie
- 20 Fine weather finished painting the out side except the name 2 Steamers came in had fresh beef sent on board
- 21 Painted the heads another Coat and painted the name on the Stern pumped 6 barrels of oil and sent on shore
- 22 Fine weather tared down the jib and flying jib stays Set out the jib stay filled a 10 barrel oil cask with salt water
- 23 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day washed off fore and aft with soda water
- 24 Fine weather got the ship ready for sea
