

- 15 Fine weather Shipped 3 men could not get them on board to day
- 16 Fine weather got all hands on board calm so we could not get out
- 17 At 7 am got under way and tomed out moderate all day
- 18 Sunday begins with moderate weather latter part fine breeze Saw Porpoises Saw one Seal Saw the Islands of Brava fogo and St. Pags
- 19 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day Saw the Islands of Fogo and Brava Saw Porpoises Shook one and lost him
- 20 This day begins with fine weather middle and latter part Squally Saw 2 large Breaches did not make out any thing lat 15-23
- 21 This day begins with a fresh breeze and Squally and continues through the day Saw Black fish and Porpoises lat 15-50 lon 29-50 at Sun Set took in Pk and double reefed the foresail
- 22 This day begins with fresh trades and Squally middle and latter part Clear Saw Blackfish lat 16-11 lon 30-50 made a nice hinch and hencoop

- 23 Fresh trades painted the vice hinch and triworks Saw one Seal bound 11 Saw Porpoises lat 15-50 lon 31-56
- 24 This day begins with fresh trades and Squally at 10 am hove to under double reefed foresail took jib and trisail
- 25 Sunday fresh trades and Squally Schooner hove to under took jib and double reefed foresail and trisail
- 26 Fresh trades and Squally Saw Porpoises at 6 am kept off SSW lat 14-20 lon 32-45 at Sun Set brought to on the Port tack
- 27 Smooth weather but Smoky Saw a fin back whale painted the top of the trunk lat 13-30
- 28 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day running off W lat 12-50 lon 33-20
- 29 Fine weather at day light made all Sail kept off NW by W lat 12-34 lon 34
- 30 This day begins with fine weather at day light Set the main sail and fly jib at 11 am took in main sail more wind at 4 P.M. Saw whales going quick could not get hold lat 13 lon 35
- 31 Fresh trades kept off NW at 4 pm hauled up 11 Squally lat 12-58 lon 35-31
