- 10 Fresh trades throughout the day lat 11-26 lon 43-22
- 11 This day begins with fresh trades and continues through the day lat 12-28 lon 43-47
- 12 This day begins with a fresh breeze and continues through the day Saw a Bark running off a whale lat 13-11 lon 44-14
- 13 Sunday fresh trades Saw a Bark bound W lat 13-37 lon 44-43
- 14 This day begins with fresh trades Saw the Schooner at gate Cutting a 20 barrel Whale lat 13-57 lon 45-23
- 15 Fresh breeze Saw Blackfish Gamma with the Brig D & Small lat 13-55 lon 45-25
- 16 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day at 9 am let the main sail Saw the Brig D & Small lat 13-49 lon 45-27
- 17 Fine weather throughout the day Saw the Brig D & Small lat 13-49 lon 45-08

- 18 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day at 11-45 am Saw whales went down and got one took him alongside and cut him in lat 13-20 lon 45-30
- 19 This day begins with a fresh breeze and continues through the day at 9 am Started the work lat 13-18 lon 45-26
- 20 Sunday this day begins with fine weather and continues through the day at 5 am finished boiling Stowed down 25 barrels in all lat 17-35 lon 45-08
- 21 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day Saw one sail washed off fore and aft with Goda lat 13-06 lon 45-23
- 22 Fine weather Saw a Brig running off Coopered and flaged a Reef Bask lat 13-30 lon 45-34
- 23 This day begins with thick weather and gradually and continues through the day lat 13-06 lon 45-30
- 24 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day Saw a Bark running off W lat 13-25 lon 45-43
- 25 Fresh breeze throughout the day at 2 am Saw whales got a small calf took him in whale and striped him lat 13-20 lon 46-17 tore the main sail
