

- 26 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day on bent the old mainsail and bent the new one Saw 2 Sail running off missed our whale lat 12-55 lon 46-12
- 27 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day hoisted out our whale lat 13-43 lon 46-17
- 28 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day gained with the Barb Perry lat 13-25 lon 46-30
- 29 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day at 6 am set the mainsail and gaff top sail and kept off W by N lat 14- lon 47-55
- 30 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day Saw Grampus carried away one side of the jaws of the fore gaff cut off the foot of the foresail to make it smaller and done other repairs lat 14-11 lon 49-58
- 31 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day Saw one sail running off W finished repairing the foresail sent down the gaff top sail and repaired it and sent it up run off W all day lat 13-44 lon 52-11

- 1 Pure the first begins with fine weather and continues through the day Saw a Bark running W Saw a Grampus lat 13-10 lon 54-39
- 2 This day begins with a fresh breeze and squally running off W lat 13-03 lon 57-20
- 3 Sunday begins with a fresh breeze at 1 pm Saw the Island of Barbadoes at 4 & came to anchor
- 4 This day begins with squally weather latter part fine Broke out a ground tier cask that leaked cleaned off the Starboard side and painted the hends
- 5 Fresh breeze but fine weather cleaned the Port side of the vessel and painted the hends and yellow stripe side Sticked part of the jib
- 6 Fine weather at work all day on the mainsail
- 7 Finished the mainsail and bent the old foresail
- 8 Got 50 barrels of water side Sticked the jib and bent it
- 9 This day begins with rain and continues most of the day but little work done on account of rain
- 10 Sunday fresh breeze one work on spare
