

- 11 This day begins with heavy squalls of rain middle and latter part less rain at noon hoisted the main sail tacky sent the men on shore that we got at Cape verd Islands to have them put on the articles
- 12 This day begins with steady rain and continues through the day no work done on account of rain
- 13 This day begins with steady rain and moderate at 9am got under way and went to sea after getting out a few miles it died out calm
- 14 This day begins with a light breeze and fine weather saw a brig bound to Barbados latter part fresh breeze
- 15 This day begins with a fresh breeze and squally at 9am took in the mainsail lat 16 lon 58-17
- 16 This day begins with fine weather at 8am set the mainsail and topsail at 6pm took in topsail fresh breeze spoke the Schooner Elizabeth De Hart of Bath bound to Barbados lat 17-26 lon 58-14

- 17 Sunday begins with fine weather and continues through the day lat 19-05 lon 58-14
- 18 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day saw a bark and brig running W on bent the ~~old~~ mainsail and bent the old one repaired the trisail lat 20-16 lon 58-17
- 19 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day saw Porpoises lat 21-46 lon 57-35
- 20 This day begins with a light breeze and fine weather middle and latter part squally saw Porpoises and Grampuses on bent the old mainsail and bent the new one
- 21 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day wind SE lat 23-54 lon 56-18 bore up the old mainsail
- 22 This day begins with a light breeze and fine weather and continues through the day lat 24-54
- 23 This day begins with moderate weather and continues through the day saw Grampuses painted the vessel in tide lat 25-33 lon 55-15
- 24 Sunday begins with a light breeze and squally middle and latter part fine lat 25-38 lon 55
