

- 27 Fresh breeze and Squally wind S.W. running off all day Saw one Sail lat 33-59 lon 42-15 Spoke the Schooner Ellen Rodman
- 28 This day begins with a fresh breeze and Squally and continues through the day Saw 2 whales lat 33-05 lon 41-42 Saw Grampuses
- 29 Sunday begins with calm weather middle and latter part light breeze Saw the Schooner Ellen Rodman chasing whales She galled them before we saw them no lat or lon
- 30 This day begins with fine weather and continues throughout the day Saw Porpoises wind S.W. lat 33-55 lon 41-16
- 31 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day Saw a Bark Standing to the S.E. a whaler Saw Grampuses lat 33-55 lon 44-10
- August the first begins with moderate weather and fine latter part Squally Saw Grampuses wind S.S.E. lat 33-45 lon 41-52
- 2 This day begins with fine weather middle and latter part fresh breeze and Squally at day light Saw whales went down but did not get hold going quick to windward lat 33-45 lon 42-09

- 3 This day begins with Squally weather latter part fine weather Saw one Sail lat 33-42 lon 42-02
- 4 This day begins with a light breeze latter part calm at 8 am Saw a large white water at 9 am made out a lone whale at 10 went down after him and got him got him alongside at 2 pm ran off the cutting gear and cut until dark lat 33-49 lon 42-02
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- 5 This day begins with fine weather latter part ruff at day light went to work cutting lost the case and part of the junk 48 at 8 pm Started the work lat 33-49
- 6 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day with a heavy swell from the N.W. randed up all of the blubber lat 33-36 lon 41-52
- 7 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day cut up the junk at 8 pm finished boiling the laddy Stowed down 40 barrels of the oil lat 33-58 lon 41-45
- 8 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day at 7 am finished boiling Stowed down the rest of the oil 85 barrels in all craped and Stowed down the Cables lat 34-05 lon 41-35
