- 26 Sunday fine weather throughout the day wind SW lat $33^{\circ}35'$ lon $34^{\circ}48'$
- 27 This day begins with fine weather and continues throughout the day let the english Bark Sea racer have a little flour Saw Grampuses lat $33^{\circ}41'$ lon 34°
- 28 This day begins with fine weather middle and latter part fresh breeze wind SW Saw a Bark
- 29 This day begins with a fresh breeze and squally middle and latter part thick wind NW Saw a Ship bound NE lat 36° lon 32°
- 30 This day begins with fine weather and continues throughout the day wind N lat $36^{\circ}25'$ lon $30^{\circ}12'$
- 31 This day begins with fine weather middle calm latter part rain lat $36^{\circ}14'$
- September the first thick weather and some rain wind SE at 9 am Saw whales went down and struck a small one did not see any more after striking one took

- him along side and cut him in and ranged up the blubber at 5 pm kept off
- 2 Sunday begins with thick weather and continues through the day with some rain cut up the whales head and put it in junk cask at 1 pm Saw the Island of Flores Saw a Bark lying off on a on
- 3 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day had it calm part of the day under the lee of the Island Saw 2 Barks at 4 pm started the work
- 4 Fine weather throughout the day at 4 am finished boiling washes of and stowed down the oil at 4 am went on shore and got off recruits at 6 1/2 pm kept off for Fayal
- 5 This day begins with a fresh breeze and continues through the day at noon Saw Pice at 1 pm took in the main sail and fly jib wind NW
- 6 This day begins with a fresh breeze middle and latter part moderate rain part the north side of Fayal Saw a Bark and Schooner lying off Fayal
