

- 7 This day begins with fine weather middle squally latter part fine run down off whale rock. Saw cow fish
- 8 This day begins with fine weather wind NW latter part fresh breeze wind W. Saw Grampuses
- 9 This day begins with squally weather and continues through the day Schooner under foresail, trisail and jib Sunday
- 10 This day begins with a fresh breeze and squally with a heavy sea. Saw Porpoises and Grampuses Schooner under jib foresail and trisail. Caught a turtle
- 11 This day begins with a light breeze and a heavy swell and continues through the day. Saw Grampuses and killed 1 wind 11
- 12 This day begins with a moderate breeze middle and latter part fresh at 3 pm took in mainsail and flying jib and set the trisail. Caught a Gun fish at 10 pm took the boom out of the jib
- 13 This day begins with a fresh breeze and continues through the day with thick weather and rain at 11 am split the jib from head to foot and bent it and bent the trisail for a jib

- 14 This day begins with a moderate breeze and thick weather with rain latter part fine breeze at 6 1/2 pm came to anchor at Bayal found 7 whales at anchor
- 15 This day begins with a moderate breeze and thick weather middle and latter part fine loaded sails and dried them scraped and flushed the masts fore and aft and scrubbed the cut side and broke out a cask of beef at 9 pm took a morning
- 16 Sunday begins with fine weather latter part thick wind SSE
- 17 This day begins with a fresh breeze and rain latter part clear weather but ruff took out 4 ground tier casks of oil
- 18 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day cooped and filled off 8 casks of oil and put them on board the Fred Gray
- 19 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day cooped 5 casks and took them on board the Schooner Fred Gray. Stowed 13 casks on board the Fred Gray got 6 cask from there
- 20 This day begins with moderate weather latter part fresh breeze. Stowed off the ground tier and filled 12 casks with salt water got 2 barrels of beef from the Schooner Fred Gray and 2 casks
