

- 6 This day begins with a fresh breeze and rain at 8 am Saw the Island of Hayal kept off an run down between Fayal and Pico to ruff for the Boat to come off run through the Channel and and hauled to the 4
- 7 Sunday begins with a fresh breeze from the SE and a heavy sea at day light Hayal bearing SSW 20 miles
- 8 This day begins with moderate weather and continues through the day repaired the old trisail worked up within 4 or 5 miles of Hayal and at 2 pm Saw 2 large whales went down and struck one took the line and lost him
- 9 This day begins with moderate weather run in between Fayal and Pico at 5 pm the Captain came off left a boat there on shore sick.
- 10 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day went in to the 4 of Hayal to Cruise wind ESE
- 11 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day wind ESE Cruised off the 11 of Hayal

- 12 This day begins with fine weather and continues through the day Saw a finback off the 11 of Hayal
- 13 This day begins with a moderate breeze middle and latter part fresh breeze at 10 am went on shore got a new jib and the sick man kept off wind NW at 5 pm double reefed the foresail
- 14 Sunday begins with a moderate breeze and a heavy swell wind 11 latter part wind ESE
- 15 This day begins with fine weather wind SE latter part a fresh breeze wind SE by S at 14 pm took in the mainsail and flying jib
- 16 This day begins with fine weather middle part rain at 7 am set the mainsail at 2 pm Saw the Island of St Michael's bearing S 15 miles
- 17 This day begins with a light breeze from the S W and continues through the day
- 18 This day begins with a light breeze middle thick of fog latter part clear at 5 pm hauled the jib to windward off the back water
