 bound to rear saw Poppus at 7 PM
 Mid night rain and some fog wind from the
 NW till 3 AM on the 13th the racket sound
 round to the NW on the 24th

13 July Saturday 1878 all of this day strong
 breeze from the SW to SW by W
 running of V. & C. Souch this day saw
 some large and some small blowing
 at 8 PM ahead sail for night
 running of V. & C. wind right aft throat
 and reef foresail and file mid
 night the same or ends this 24th

Sunday July 1878 this day fine weather
 all day ship head to the Southward
 all day till 8 PM then to the W
 NW at 8 PM ahead sail for the
 night Lat 37 41 - Long 122 35 mid night
 head to the weatherward all night made
 at 10 ends this 24th & night the
 boatswain head the weather

15 Monday July 1878 this day clear
 the most of the time saw Poppus
 grampos rollers and facts up head
 of 1 mast some gone later to it
 go ends this day clear at 8 PM
 A ship head NW by W mid night
 clear to the weatherward all
 night under ahead sail head NW
 by W on ends this 24th
