 from 3 masts his length
 was 150 ft the compass time
 to weather and eye time was
 12 minutes from this time so
 ends this day head to the
 weather all day 3 days
 out of 3 masts saw some
 others just during the day
 saw paper and most of
 them all day pasting to
 the SW so ends 24th 1878

 32.14 this day fine weather all
 72.47 day ship evening saw one steamer to
 N. westward and tow whaling
 at 5 PM east boats board the

 to the Northward so ends 24th 1878

 Thursday Aug. the 8th 1878
 38.45 this 24th moderate all day
 72.49 ship evening in the lat of 36.40 at 12
 4 PM head in to the SW till 2 PM
 then to the NW 3 Whalmon in
 sight till 4 PM the tow in sight
 to day board the Vehr of J. Knight
 of 4 masts board with some
 bound to the Northward so ends this
 24th under trisail and 4th sail for the
 night

 Friday Aug. the 9th 1878 this day fine weather
 36.57 all till 4 PM then the wind came
 73.00 up from the SW fresh to day 3
 Whalmon in sight at 1 PM sail
 with Vehr Express so ends the day
 saw plainly of papered so ends 24th fresh
 SW wind

 Saturday Aug. the 10th 1878 all of this day
 36.48 fresh breeze from the SW with
 74.57 the Express in sight all day so ends 24th
 1878

 Sunday Aug. the 11th 1878 this day commenced with
 36.32 steady weather wind SW 10
 4 PM wind NW wind at 9 PM NW
 same light rain during the day at 11
 PM a single from the NW during
 where ship were the boards came
 3 right in the rest of the day
 cloudy from 11 AM till 4 PM light
 breeze from the NW at 4 PM
