Wednesday Aug the 14 1878 This day the first part rainy and moderate ship head to the Westward the last part fine weather at 2 PM all sail out saw swell sail to the shore of 24th ends 24th under short sail and forecast

Thursday Aug the 15 1878 This day all the first part rainy and drizzle ship head out to the West the last part better weather saw swell coarse fog in AM whole on return with him his family to 3.44 and on at 12 AM all day 2 PM out the mackerel all sail out till 1 PM in mackerel and at the forecast head 26th ends 24th

Friday Aug the 16 1878 This day fine weather head to the West all day making 2 PM the forecast the last part of the day saw 78-50 swell sail in sight 3 whatmon in sight head some light showers of rain during the day no wind this 24th under short sail

Saturday Aug the 17 1878 This day fine weather saw 3 whatmon and at 3 PM 3 PM gamb with the 4 yase and the M. J. Bright and the 6 d. Lee all in company with as 20 ends this 24th under short sail head saw 2 what from the West at 4 PM

Sunday Aug the 18 1878 All of this day moderate have sail in the first part of day at sundown the swell to day gamb with the 6 d. Lee and the 4 yase and the Rising Sun 20 ends this day and 24th under short sail

Monday Aug the 19 1878 all of this day fine weather head to the West all day in company with 5 other whatmon head the same way all in sight at sundown 20 ends this 24th under short sail this sail and job

Tuesday Aug the 20 1878 This day fine weather moderate wind from the shore 6 whatmon in sight during the day some 34 mackerel in sight 20 of to the Eastward 20 ends this 24th moderate under short sail during the night

Wednesday Aug the 21 1878 This day fine weather all day saw 7 whatmon in sight gamb with the 4 yase and at sundown the 4 yase in sight the Mary of course Ellen Rippe Rising Sun & all in sight
