 36-46 fine weather moderate air from
 72-40 the southward saw the three
 vessels in sight all day saw two
 more in sight one bound to the
 north the other to the N.E.

 Friday Sept the 6 1878
 36-40 this day fine weather all day
 72-31 saw two more whalmon so ends this
 moderate day saw some drab and
 and dolphin and porpoise and
 so ends this day fine weather
 wind from the N.E.

 Saturday Sept the 7 1878 this day commenced with
 fine weather at 5 PM wind fresh up from
 36-47 the N.E. at sundown reef the foresail and
 72-30 the jib. Strong breeze saw one brief sunny
 of south so ends this 24 sail of wind light
 sail open flower to day

 Sunday Sept the 8 this day commenced with
 36-47 fine weather all day at 8 AM the
 72-30 three vessels in sight and the capt
 came on board for five minutes so ends
 this day rising of to the eastward
 at sundown 2 more whalmon in
 sight so ends this 24 moderate day
 under trisail and got through the
 night

 Monday Sept the 9 1878 this day strong
 36-47 wind under short sail so
 72-30 ends 24
 Tuesday Sept the 10 this 24 fine weather
 36-40 all day at 8 AM the
 72-38 three vessels in sight and the capt
 came on board for five minutes so ends
 this day rising of to the eastward
 at sundown 2 more whalmon in
 sight so ends this 24 moderate day
 under trisail and got through the
 night

 36-40 weather all day saw level marches
 72-38 along the bay passing to and from so
 ends 24 under short sail for the
 night
 Thursday Sept the 12 this 24 fine weather
 36-40 all day at 8 AM the

 came on board for five minutes so ends
 this day rising of to the eastward
 at sundown 2 more whalmon in
 sight so ends this 24 moderate day
 under trisail and got through the
 night
